These trips are incredibly enriching for students but very costly. By planning early, the trips are more attainable for students.





ACCOMMODATIONS & MEALS (EUROPE)

- 4 kids per room; option to room with fewer for a fee
- No adults rooming with kids
- Parents WELCOME (Grandparents, other family members, too)
- All adults on trip need fingerprint check
- Kids must REPACK their luggage themselves.

- Many breakfasts and dinners included
- Students must purchase lunches and snacks
- Lunch Budget: \$15-20 each
- Snacks: varies
- Send Euros. Do NOT plan to exchange American dollars in Europe.

FACTS & TIPS (EUROPE)

- About two-thirds of students attend.
- Student travellers MUST have a passport.
- Students who do not attend do other activities @ DKFI.
- Trip registration begins in September of 7th Grade.
- There is an early bird discount.
- Adult-to-student ratio on trip is approx. 1:10.
- Some trip activities must be paid in Europe (e.g., Gondola ride) and are not included in the EF Tours price.

AFFORDING TRIPS

Start early and start small

- Start in Kindergarten and save monthly
- Fundraise through your travel account with relatives and friends
- Split with kids:Parents = Tour CompanyKids = Spending Money

MONTHLY SAVINGS

- Save \$60/mo. = K-8th grade
- Sept. K to Dec. 8th grade =100 months
- $$60 \times 100 \text{ months} = $6,000$

FUNDRAISE VIA TRAVEL ACCOUNT

- Works like GoFundMe
- Can send link to others to donate money to trip
- France Trip: 18 months to pay

SPLIT WITH KIDS

- Budget for to pay for the tour companies
- Have your kids save for their own spending money
- Birthday \$, extra chores,etc. = kid savings

LAST BUT NOT LEAST

Although the trips are for students, there is a lot of work involved for the parents. DKFI will hold multiple meetings each trip year for the respective 4th, 6th, and 8th grade travellers. You may need to submit notarized documents, travel permission slips, etc.

For the France trip, parents may also need to include lost/stolen passport replacement documents.

Last but not least, we recommend you purchase the travel insurance offered by each tour company. It could spare you a headache and a whole in your wallet later.
