### Legislative Committee Update

(Halima Jenkins presented)

The next <u>School Board Meeting</u> will be Tuesday, Dec. 19, at Sasscer Admin Bldg. in Upper Marlboro. Committee needs volunteer to attend and report back. PGCEA (Prince Georges County Education Association) is advocating for an elected school board and Citizens Education Council now. Through a recent report, the NEA supports the idea that a fully elected School Board is better. In PGCPS, an all-elected Board could remove the current PGCPS CEO Dr. Maxwell and put in a new CEO. Although there is good reason to ask for a fully elected School Board, it is somewhat concerning as Dr. Maxwell is an advocate of the foreign language programs in the community and a replacement for him may not be as supportive.

<u>Language Immersion Task Force:</u> DKFI representatives Halima Jenkins and Martazsh Henderson attended the November PGCPS Language Immersion Task Force meeting. Committee members compared the current PGCPS immersion models to other language immersion programs in Montgomery County, Delaware, and Minnesota. They collected data toward the goal of making recommendations to PGCPS CEO Kevin Maxwell about the best way to meet the needs of secondary (grades 6-12) language immersion students. The Task Force will continue to convene through until spring 2018.

There are currently are 9 language immersion/dual language schools in PGCPS. This includes full immersion, bilingual, and partial immersion programs in French, Spanish, and Mandarin (Chinese).
