BLAKE'S TIPS & TRICKS FOR OUR DKFI VIRTUAL LEARNING COMMUNITY

Hello,

We are the Wilson Family & Blake A. Wilson (3rd Grade) is our scholar matriculating through DKFI. Our family decided on trying the virtual option for a variety of reasons and so far it feels similar to last year. Just to be clear, our last year with the 2nd grade team, ELA, Tech, Music & Art went very well. Now that we have settled into a new school year this is proving to be the same.

Insight:

Given there was less than 1 week's time frame for DKFI to put together a virtual learning experience, there were a couple of hiccups in the initial roll out of links and a little confusion on the days and times for classes, but Dr. Mills put together a great clickable schedule that Blake likes because it makes things easy to follow. We are trying to learn how to navigate Canvas, give yourself some time and grace...honestly we are just going to go to YouTube & watch some simple videos to understand how it works.

Tips/Tricks

- 1. Have your child open up their PGCPS Chrome browser, go into Dr. Mills' Google Classroom, click on the schedule (usually at the very top) and create a favorites Bookmark that stays at the top of your child's screen when they login. This gives them quick access to the schedule & it updates anytime the document's links are updated.
- 2. If you utilize Google on your cell phone(s) & you have a Google Home device, you can utilize the Family Bells option to create alarms for each class your child has to attend. It sounds like a school bell & can be programmed to announce the name of each class/teacher that they are to attend. Just make sure to set it to go off about 2 3 minutes prior to the actual start of the class to factor in any time for tech issues.
- 3. Before the start of the school day, have your child open up a tab that is set to just their emails so they can see when teachers assign them classwork or homework. This is also helpful if a teacher is absent & needs them to work independently.

- 4. If you can, hook up your chromebook to multiple monitors/tvs to be able to see the virtual class & keep your assignment up on the other screen at the same time. This prevents your child from having to toggle between windows when teachers are sharing their screens and wanting them to complete assignments concurrently.
- 5. To reduce eye strain, have your student utilize glasses that block the computer's blue lights or change the computer's display settings to reduce the hue emitted.

We hope everyone is having a great year thus far & Blake can't wait to see his greater DKFI friends in the near future!

The Maryland Seal of Biliteracy

The Maryland Seal of Biliteracy is an award given by participating school systems that recognizes a student's high level of proficiency in listening, speaking, reading and writing in one or more languages other than English. Begun in California in 2011, the Seal of Biliteracy is now offered in 36 states and Washington, DC. Maryland's Seal of Biliteracy Bill was signed into law in 2016. High school graduates who can function in two or more languages are equipped with the knowledge and skills to participate successfully in college, careers, and a diverse 21st century society. The Maryland State Seal of Biliteracy is established to recognize and reward excellence in language learning as measured by rigorous proficiency assessments. 228 Prince George's County Public School students earned this seal last year.

Junior Achievement (JA) Finance Park



DORA KENNEDY FRENCH IMMERSION CARDINAL PRIDE

LEGACY

Founded in 1985 by Dr. Dora Funari Kennedy (1921-2009), Dora Kennedy French Immersion is a magnet school located in Greenbelt, Maryland. It is a lottery-based specialty program serving students in grades K-8. DKFl, originally called Robert F. Goddard French Immersion School, is one of the oldest French Immersion schools in the United States. In 2015, the school's name was changed to Dora Kennedy French Immersion in honor of our founder, a long-time Maryland Educator. Dr. Kennedy served as a teacher for many years and became the president of the Maryland Foreign Language Association and an executive member of the American Council on Teaching of Foreign Languages. She co-founded the National Museum of Language in College Park, MD and became the first foreign language supervisor in the county's school system.

In 2014, the school was awarded the esteemed designation of being a National Blue Ribbon School by the US Department of Education. The National Blue Ribbon Schools Program recognizes and honors elementary, middle, and high schools that exhibit high performance and/ or significant improvement in student achievement, including reducing the achievement gap for disadvantaged students. The school also was awarded the National PTA School of Excellence Award in 2020

All DKFI core subjects are taught in French beginning in Kindergarten. In second grade, the curriculum begins to implement English instruction. In sixth grade, Russian is available as an elective subject for students, becoming an academic requirement in 7th grade. Our teachers include mostly native French speakers from all over the world, including Morocco, France, and Cameroon. In the past, our students have received top honors in the Diplome d'Etudes en Langue Française, a certification of competency in French, from the French Ministry of Education.

Our school is celebrating a rich legacy of over 36 years of French Education. As proud parents of Dora Kennedy French Immersion, we are committed to working with the administration of the school to carry the torch of excellence into the future, ensuring the success of our students...
